Updated on 21.07.2022 (Updates in highlight)

The CEV Beach Volley Nations Cup is a newly introduced CEV competition with the aim of complementing the existing Beach Volleyball structures, giving additional playing opportunities to the European athletes and providing a platform that National Federations can exploit to facilitate their athletes' development programs and promote their teams.

The competition is played in a country-vs-country format where each National Federation participates with 2 teams. Men's and Women's competitions are separated.

COVID - 19 Statement

The overall situation regarding Covid-19 in Austria has improved significantly with the local authorities and lawmakers having lifted many of the preventative measures adopted to curb the spread of the virus. In particular, there is currently no control of vaccination or recovery status planned for the CEV Beach Volley Nations Cup tournament.

Hygiene protocols

Following a recommendation of the CEV Medical Commission, in countries where there are no restrictions in place to curb the spread of the novel coronavirus, the organisers and all relevant stakeholders do not have to follow the provisions of the relevant, latest CEV Hygiene Guidelines – Beach Volleyball Specifications.'

Nevertheless and to ensure a safe event for all persons involved, the following recommendations and guidelines to every accredited participant of the event are in place:

- Hygiene measures should be always observed. These include frequent and thorough hand washing and coughing and sneezing into the crook of the arm or into a paper handkerchief.
- When a minimum distance of 1.50m cannot be maintained in closed areas, medical mouth protection is recommended. The same principle is also recommended for local and international transportation
- Persons with a confirmed SARS Cov-2 infection will not be allowed access to the venue and will be required to go into isolation. If a person is diagnosed with Covid-19 infection after arrival his/her National Federation will take over all medical & accommodation expenses while in Austria

All Delegation members need to be accommodated in the official Event Hotel from the arrival to the day after elimination.

Should the Host National Federation appear in the top 7 NFs in the CEV country ranking, or any National Federations withdraws, the additional spot(s) will be allocated to the next ranked NF according to the CEV Country ranking as of the same day.</p> <p>When two or more NFs have the same amount of points in the CEV Country Ranking, their order is established as per the conditions set in the CEV Beach Volleyball Competitions Regulations.</p>

REPLACEMENT OF ATHLETE PROCEDURE	<p>Before the registration deadline, a National Federation may substitute an athlete from a team through the VIS, without any consequences.</p> <p>After the Registration deadline, a National Federation may substitute only one athlete per team from the competition in case of injury/medical reason or "force majeure" through the CEV BV-03 form; respective proof or documentation must be presented to the CEV.</p> <p>National Federations that decide to include a 5th athlete in their official delegation need to inform the CEV in writing on the registration deadline date. This athlete needs to attend the Preliminary Inquiry and may substitute any of the 4 athletes prior to any country-vs-country double header</p>
PRELIMINARY INQUIRY	<p><u>For Women:</u> August 1st from 16:00 to 17:30 at Hotel InterContinental</p> <p><u>For Men:</u> August 2nd from 14:00 to 15:30 at Hotel InterContinental</p> <p>Players and Delegation members are required to attend the Preliminary Inquiry and present their passports, uniforms/accessories. We also ask you to bring your bikini bottoms and shorts for an eventual photo shooting.</p> <p>Only people accredited through the respective CEV forms will be acknowledged as delegation members (see Accreditation section of the document). The CEV in cooperation with the LOC will allocate specific time slots for each National Federation to the Preliminary Inquiry</p>
COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>The event will be played using a modified pool play followed by a 6 teams single elimination phase in a "best-of-three" format.</p> <p>Each NF participating in each country vs country clash "double-header" with 2 teams, as per the following sequence:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <u>Match No. 1:</u> The teams with the smallest sum of entry ranking points from each NF - <u>Match No. 2:</u> The teams with the highest sum of entry ranking points from each NF - <u>Match No. 3 - "Golden SET"</u> – in case of a tie in won and lost matches: a SET of 15 points without a cap will be played right after the end of the 2nd match. <p>In such case, the person nominated as Head of Delegation confirms in writing to the CEV Supervisor after end of the 2nd match which athletes will play the Golden SET. This SET can be played in any combination of the 4 athletes having played Matches 1 & 2.</p> <p>The composition of the 2 teams for each "double header" will be handed by the Head of Delegation to the competition management by 8pm the day before and can combine any of the athletes that have been inscribed in the Preliminary Inquiry.</p>
